



NBACC COVID-19 POLICIES AND BEST PRACTICES FOR VISITORS

1. Screening Upon Entry to NBACC
 - a. Visitors will have their temperature taken daily upon entering the NBACC facility. Visitors with a temperature at or above 100.4° F will not be allowed to remain in the building.
 - b. Visitors are required to acknowledge that they have not traveled internationally, been in contact with persons with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 disease nor experienced symptoms consistent with COVID-19 disease in the previous 14 days prior to visiting NBACC.
2. Mask Policy
 - a. Mask use is required for entering the facility. Masks will be provided if a visitor does not have one.
 - b. Mask types include surgical-style, filtering facepiece respirators and cloth masks. The intent of the mask is to reduce dispersion of potential exhaled virus containing particles that could cause infection to others by aerosol route of exposure.
 - c. Individuals are expected to wear masks when not physically working in their assigned locations or anytime that there is a likelihood of coming within 6 feet of another worker for a sustained period (several minutes) of time.
3. Size of Allowable Gatherings
 - a. Size of gatherings will be capped based on the ability to maintain social distancing (at least 6 feet apart), but as a general rule, no more than six individuals should be physically gathered for any business or social meeting within the building.
4. Eating Areas
 - a. Strongly discourage eating in groups, unless outside and social distancing can be maintained.
 - b. Staff should sit at least 6 feet apart, especially since it is not possible to wear masks as PPE while engaging in this activity.
5. Restrooms
 - a. The number of individuals in the restroom is limited to 2 (both wearing masks).
